- * The competition is open to all residents, businesses, associations, community groups, and schools within Basingstoke & Deane Borough.
- * Competition entrants may enter up to TWO 'garden' (including 'container garden') categories, plus ONE 'single container' category of their choice.
- * **With the exception of rear garden categories, ALL garden competition entries must be both visible and accessible from a public right of way.**
- * Rear garden competition entrants will be required to submit 3-5 photos of their garden for short-listing. Photos may be submitted electronically via the website or in hard copy by post (see contact details above). Successfully short-listed entrants will be contacted for viewing/judging by appointment.
- * Applications can be submitted online.
- * Photos of gardens entered in the competition may be published on the official Basingstoke in Bloom website, or otherwise used and/or displayed for Basingstoke in Bloom promotional purposes.
- * School competition containers/gardens must predominantly be designed and grown by the pupils, who will be expected by the judges to demonstrate an interest in and understanding of the various plants grown, for example their specific requirements (light, watering, soil, etc.), habits, advantages, etc.
- * The Judges' decisions shall be final

- * **School competition** entry forms must be received by the closing date of **Friday 7th July 2017**.
- * **Garden competition** entry forms must be received by the closing date of **Friday 14th July 2017**.
- * The School competition judging will take place week beginning **17th July 2017**.
